Vandemonian is a 3-piece progressive post rock band from 3 corners of the globe. Guitarist and vocalist Nick Braren, from Tasmania, Australia, bassist Ben Feddersen from the American Midwest and Alex Benthin from Hamburg, Germany, where the band is based.

Their **guitar-driven** music connects progressive and dynamic song structures with **unconventional rhythms** and time signatures. **Atmospheric** elements of **post rock**



are met with **dissonant guitar tones**, driving bass and upbeat, **jazz-infused drumming**. Roughly half the songs are **instrumental**.

Their self-titled Vandemonian EP was released in Autumn 2016.

Xenophilia was recorded and produced by guitarist and vocalist Nick Braren between late 2018 and early 2020. The DIY-approach was largely due to Nick's background in audio, and a desire to retain all creative freedom during the process. The extended timeframe of the project was largely a result of other projects and work commitments, yet the ideas were given time to mature between tracking the band live at the end 2018 and the production, overdubs and mixing work which took place over the next year. Like the proverbial art that cannot be rushed, this was an album that evolved over time.
