### Soundcheck

Required soundcheck time varies between 40 and 60 minutes, provided that the venue is free from technical bugs.

#### PA

A PA (Public Adress) System proportionate to the Venues dimension and acoustical characteristics is required. It should manage a 20Hz – 20kHz frequency spectrum, and maximum 110 dB(SPL) without distortion.

## **Stage monitors**

Than.eye have their own monitoring system through Headphones/IEM where every band member can mix his/her own monitor using his Mobile Phone through a 5GHz WLAN.

To make this possible certain channels must go through Vasilis' Rack where they'll then be splitted, once for the FOH and once for the band's monitoring. (It is not as complicated as it sounds, more detailed Infos to be found in the Inputlists below!!!)

### **Important:**

For stages bigger than 6x4m(which is also the minimum Stage size that the band can fit in), 1 extra monitor line for 2 Speakers preferably on speaker Stands as Stage "sidefills" plus 1 extra monitor line as Wedge for the Drummer is required. (2 Monitor Lines in total)

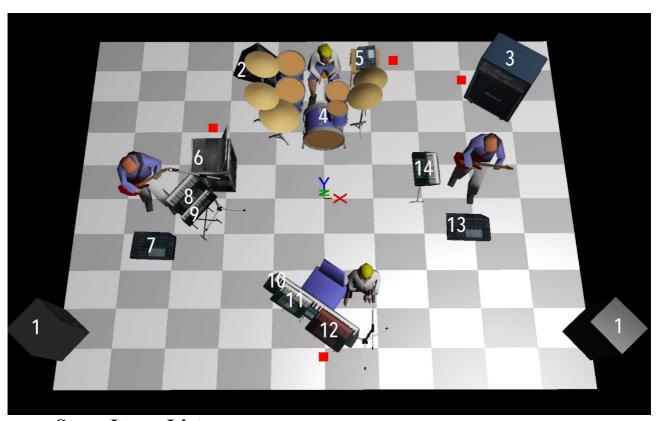
