Technical Rider

General:

- Usually the whole band uses in-ear monitoring! This depends on the size of the location and as well on the slot and has to be discussed before the event!
- Strong, good sounding PA (no DIY or cheap series) with enough headroom (Also in the lower frequencies).
- Guarantee of 100 dB (A) at the FOH place.
- Stage minimum 6,00 m x 4,00 m
- Band (5 people) + Crew (1-2 people)

FOH:

- 16 Input Channels
- Min. 4 Aux-Sends
- Effects: Reverb, Delay
- Microphones are to be provided by the organizer / technician. After consultation, microphones can also be provided by Sweeping Death.

Monitoring:

InEar-Monitoring Rack consisting of:

- Behringer X32 rackmixer + WIFI-Access
- 2x Art S8 8-channel signalsplitter
- 4x Shure PSM 300 Transmitter P3T + 4 Bodypacks Shure P3RA
- 16-channel Multicore IEM-Rack to stagebox

Additional infos:


- Phantom power for microphones / DI boxes is provided by the Behringer X32
- Each band member creates his mix on his own!
- If available, the X32 can be connected directly via AES (Rj45 Connection)

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Stage Rider

General:

On the day of the concert, a responsible person of the local organizer must be available from the beginning of the load in until the end of the event and the dismantling on site.

Assembly, Disassembly, Soundcheck:

The band would be pleased about a pre-determined realistic timetable that everyone will follow attention to. Less waiting time = more pleasure.

Stage:

The stage area should not be less than 6 x 4 m. Otherwise please contact us. We use candles as an integral part of our stage show. If this is not possible, please contact us urgently!

Merchandising:

Sweeping Death requires a well visible wall surface with 1 up to 2 tables for the merchandising stand. These are provided by the organizer.

Sweeping Death has the sole right to sell their own items such as: CDs, posters, T-shirts etc. We won't pay no additional charges for the stand such as rental or similar.

Security:

The organizer cares for the safety of the audience.

Sound-/ Light Equipment:

The artist's receiving full right for the use of the local sound and light system. There must be at least one technician available throughout the event.

The organizer is liable for any damage to the local sound and light system.

Others:

1 liter of water must be available on stage for each bandmember.

Parking

Sweeping Death need's a secure parking spot near the club or venue for 1 bus (Fiat Ducato) or 2 cars.

Wardrobe:

The band is very happy about a wardrobe, ideally lockable or otherwise secured (security, etc.). Chairs, sofas or similar and a table would be terrific.

Guestlist:

The band receives guest list / free tickets to a reasonable extent. The number of tickets has to be determined before the concert!

Catering:

A warm meal would be nice, but any kind of food gives the energy needed for an energetic gig!

Drinks:

Water (especially for the stage), soft drinks, beer, sometimes coffee as well: P
