Additional information:

- Drums: Normally we bring our cymbals, snare & double kick pedal
- Toms: **3 Toms are mandatory** (10"/12"/14") for backline, 4 Toms (10"/12"/14"/16") would be better. **In case** this is **not possible, please contact us** (ornsteen.official@gmail.com) so we can arrange bringing needed equipment with us.
- We are playing normally through a **pre-wired In-Ear Rack** which passively splits the signal to a stagebox. **Two multicore cables (each 8 x XLR)** are available to **patch** through **to** the **stagebox**.

MONITORING / WIRELESS

In case the InEar-Rack is used, no additional monitoring is required and InEar-mixing is done by the band through the IEM-Rack itself. Guitars and In-Ear monitors are wireless.

In case IEM-Rack cannot be used due to technical or logistical limitations each band member requires 1 x Monitorbox (see also page 6).

PHANTOM POWER / 48V

Phantom power is supplied through the IEM-Rack of the band.

Alternatively, phantom power supply from the FOH to the splitter of the IEM-Rack is also possible. Please let us know, so we can turn the phantom power at our IEM-Rack off.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION


Please contact us at <u>least 10 days</u> in advance of the event **if** there are any issues regarding the technical rider / backline and **adjustments** are **needed** to be made.


