DIRTY DEEDS formed on February 19, 2000 in Heidelberg, Germany, for a concert on the occasion of the 20th anniversary of Bon Scotts' death. This is why the show features only songs by or with Bon Scott. The audience was so enthusiastic at the time that the session band turned into a straight regular band.

The spectacular stage show of singer Marcus "BC" Pföhler and the authentic interpretation of the guitar- and rhythm- section keeps raising the number of fans constantly.

Sold shows around Heidelberg, Germany, proved the first success.

In February 2002, Alex Kraft (Jail, Tom Angelripper, Dezperadoz) joined the band as guitar player. He was followed in April 2003 by the bass player Alex Weigand (Pussy, Dead Anyway, Dezperadoz). The line-up was complete.

Now **DIRTY DEEDS** played big shows in Kabul, Afghanistan (for the ISAF troups), in Switzerland, W.O.A. Wacken Open Air 2006 & 2008 (which is the biggest heavy metal open air festival in the world), Wacken Seaside Festival 2009, Lübeck, Martix-Bochum, Hamburg and many other locations in Germany.

DIRTY DEEDS is:

Alex Kraft (guitar, vocals), Stefan Pollich (guitar, vocals), Alex Weigand (bass, vocals), Martin Jug (drums) and Marcus "BC" Pföhler (vocals) – so the classic AC/DC- line up of the Bon Scott era is complete.

DIRTY DEEDS plays nearly all songs from the first 5 albums.

From "Highway To Hell" - "T-N-T" - "Sin City" - "Let There Be Rock" - "Girls Got Rhythm" - "Riff Raff" or "The Jack" **DIRTY DEEDS** plays the songs with a skilful mixture of authentic interpretation, spontaneity and humor, not to get into moronic covering.
