

D-WALL is a German Heavyrock Band from Hannover.

The story behind the name was the result of the level adjustments of the backline during one of the first band rehearsals.

After a few D major chords, the name D-WALL was born.

The band was founded 1999, initially as a classic Hard Rock and Heavy Metal band, by Dietmar Naujok, Olaf Sylvester Karsten Scholz, Arno Kädtler and DeHaan.

After the guitarist Karsten Scholz left the band, a few other successors have been tested.

Finally in 2007 an equivalent replacement has been found in Tim Pillukat.

Already in 2005 Sandra Barclay joined the band as a background singer.

A fundamental new orientation took place in 2010 as the singer Arno Kädtler left the band and Sandra took over the main vocals. Up until then the band only had a vague idea about the full range of her singing qualities.

Also in 2010 Dietmar Naujok and Tim Pillukat decided to share the songwriting, which contributed a lot to the diversity of the current album.

After finishing the Black Tree album recordings Dietmar Naujok and DeHaan left the band.

The band can be classified between Female Fronted Heavy Rock and Modern Hard Rock.
