Sound:

The venue will provide a qualified FOH-Engineer, who will be present during sound check and concert. The signals for guitars, bass, vocals, and samples will be provided via DI from our central module. Amplifiers on stage are therefore not needed. Please see the attached signal overview for requierements. The band will bring their own microphones and XLR-Cables for vocals. Microphones for drums, mic stands, and nessecary cables (Stage to mixer) will be provided by the venue.

Monitors:

The band plays with its own IEM system and does not need monitor wedges on stage. Ego risers for guitars and bass would be appreciated. If monitor wedges are already on the stage, they do not need to be removed.

Light:

The band comes without its own light and without a lighting technician. We would be happy to have an experienced lighting technician provided by the venue.

Electricity:

Three sockets (230V), at the right rear of the stage (FOH-View), are to be provided. These are needed to operate the bands central module.

Backstage:

The venue will provide a backstage area that is inaccessible to unauthorized people, where the travel party can temporarily store instruments, cases and personal belongings, retreat and prepare for the show.

Merchandise:

The band will bring merchandise and is in need of a suitable space, a table, and a way to hang t-shirts, etc. A sufficient possibility, provided by the venue, is highly appreciated.

Catering:

We are happy to have a warm, vegetarian meal sometime between get-in and at least an hour before the show starts. When it comes to drinks, we enjoy beer, still and sparkling water, softdrinks, coffee, and tea.
