BIOGRAPHY

Founded in Tübingen, Germany, in December 2004. Ever since the reception of The Savants has been exceptionally well. Their demo "Test" (2005), as well as their first album "Razzmatazz" (2007), both self produced, were critically acclaimed by the press and their audience. In 2008 they were awarded "best live act" by the local radio station. Also in 2008 they were chosen to represent their home town in a cultural exchange program with the city of Petrosavodsk, Russia. They got to play at "Vozduh", the second biggest alternative-music festival in Russia. Opening on Sunday afternoon, they left quite an impression on the organisers, so they were invited to come back the following year – this time to play Saturday night before the headliner. For the release of their second album "Mosquito Sunrise" they got a deal with "Hulk Räckorz", one of the most important punk-rock labels in Germany. Once again the critics were ecstatic. The Savants' music is an intriguing melange of raw punk-rock energy and those sweet melodies and stirring rhythms you'd find in folk-music from Ireland to Siberia. It is the intoxicating mixture of their happy-go-lucky music and their passionate live performances that regularly leaves their audience in a blissful state of exhausted bedazzlement.
