"Stranger" is the first album by Candymx, and has already sold over 3000 copies making a positive impact on several media. The Mexican punk wave band is part of the indie label Diablito Records, and they have played different gigs next to bands such as The Misfits, Crystal Castles, The Faint and The Black eyed Peas.

Candymx consists of Valentina Plasa (vocals/ bass), Michael Klotz (vocals / guitar), and Hector Villagomez (drums).

Their first sign of life was a demo they recorded in 2006 whose self-made copies they sold during gigs.

After some time of mutual interest, Candymx decided to sign with the Mexican indie label **Diablito Records**. They recorded the song "**Get away**" at the Studio **SixSixSix** in Coyoacan, (owned by Diablito Records and Miky Huidobro of Molotov) which was then included in the second edition of the first compilation "**Diablito Vol. 1**" (2008).

From august 2008 until February 2009 they recorded their first album "Stranger" at the Studio SixSixSix, produced by Diego Aguirre, mixed by Jason Carmer (who has worked with Korn, Run DMC, The Donnas, Live, System of a Down) and the mastering was done at The Lodge by Emily Lazar and Joe LaPorta (they have contributed with their talent mastering albums by Depeche Mode, Garbage, David Bowie and Lou Reed, and more recent bands such as Vampire Weekend) at New York City, United States.

"Stranger" was released May 26th 2009 under the distribution of Warner Music Mexico, and has sold over 3000 copies until now.

The song "Painkiller" was included in the compilation "Diablito Vol. II" released in October 2009.

After several concerts throughout Mexico, in cities like Torreon and Queretaro, Candymx was invited in September 2009 to be the supporting act for the legendary **The Misfits** at the Hard Rock Live in Mexico City. In December 2009 they participated at the **Goliath Festival** in Santa Fe Mexico City next to **Crystal Castles, The Faint, Fischerspooner and The Black Eyed Peas** among others.

Even though the members are of German and Peruvian descent, Candymx was born in Mexico and is therefore a Mexican band.
