

Technical Rider Off The Chains Tour 2013

This Technical Rider describes a necessary working environment. In case of any problems, please contact us as soon as possible. We will work with you to find a solution.

PA:

A high quality stereo or LRS system with sufficient power (flown whenever possible), that is capable to produce a linear, even, clear and loud sound for all parts of the audience. Feel free to use side-, nearfills and delay lines wherever necessary.

FOH:

- We bring our own mixing desk, which will be used for His Statue Falls' show only. Make sure to have enough room for a 01v96 + Small Siderack at FOH
- Please provide a multicore with min. 20 input channels and 5 return channels.
- 1/3 octave graphic equalizer for each output to PA

Monitor System:

- We bring our own five-channel In-Ear System which will be fed from FOH. Please make sure, to provide space for our In-Ear Rack next to the Drummer. Stagebox is to be located within 3m of this.

Stage:

- Drum Riser 3mx2m
- Please make sure to provide all necessary cables and stands in good condition.


Staff:

- one professional sound engineer who is familiar with the venue to support our engineer
- one professional lighting technician to run the show

Please make sure everything is set up and tested upon the artist's arrival.
